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Licensed Beds

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State Field ID	Field	Definition
Adult Licensed Beds (Ward medical/surgical beds for patients 18 and older)		
100110	Medical/Surgical	The Medical/Surgical Unit (Med/Surg) is an acute care general medical/surgical inpatient unit operating 24 hours a day.
100120	Medical/Surgical ICU	An intensive care unit, or ICU, is a specialized section of a hospital that provides comprehensive and continuous care for persons who are critically ill and who can benefit from treatment.
100130	Coronary Care Unit	A coronary care unit or cardiac intensive care unit is a hospital ward specialized in the care of patients with heart attacks, unstable angina, cardiac dysrhythmia and various other cardiac conditions that require continuous monitoring and treatment.
100140	Total Adult Licensed Beds	Total Ward medical/surgical beds for patients 18 and older

Pediatric Licensed Beds (Ward medical/surgical beds for patients 17 and younger)		
100210	Pediatrics	Pediatrics is the branch of medicine that involves the medical care of infants, children, and adolescents. The American Academy of Pediatrics recommends people be under pediatric care up to the age of 21
100220	Pediatric ICU	A pediatric intensive care unit, is an area within a hospital specializing in the care of critically ill infants, children, and teenagers.
100230	Neonatal ICU	A neonatal intensive care unit (NICU), also known as an intensive care nursery (ICN), is an intensive care unit specializing in the care of ill or premature newborn infants.
100240	Total Pediatric Licensed Beds	Total Ward medical/surgical beds for patients 17 and younger

Other Licensed Beds (Beds that are licensed, physically set up, and available for use. . These are beds regularly maintained in the hospital for the use of patients, which furnish accommodations with supporting services.)

100310	Psychiatric	Psychiatric care beds are beds accommodating in- patients for mental health (including substance abuse therapy), but excluding beds for patients who are mentally handicapped if the principal clinical intent is not of a medical nature.
100320	Substance Abuse	Substance Abuse beds are beds accommodating in- patients for mental health (including substance abuse therapy), but excluding beds for patients who are mentally handicapped if the principal clinical intent is not of a medical nature.
100330	Rehabilitation	Acute Rehabilitation is for people needing more intensive rehabilitation. This care setting can be within a hospital or housed in a separate building outside the hospital. These are usually inpatient programs- the patient is admitted to the hospital until released.
100340	Intermediate/Skilled Care	Intermediate care facility/developmentally disabled-nursing is a facility with a capacity of 4 to 15 beds that provides 24-hour personal care, developmental services, and nursing supervision for developmentally disabled persons who have intermittent recurring needs for skilled nursing care but have been certified by a physician and surgeon as not requiring availability of continuous skilled nursing care.
